

1) We have received; we need to acknowledge it!

If we are born again, we have all that Jesus is, and all the Holy Spirit is! Salvation comes with stuff; we get to use His stuff "The computer analogy!" We have the same Spirit, to do the same things, for the same purposes, and for the same reasons...**More**

When we purchase a computer it comes with many programs. When we begin to use it, we don't call the manufacture and ask for them to install these programs, they already are installed. Likewise, our salvation came with already pre-programmed stuff.

We were born again into a new creation in the same likeness of Christ Jesus. We don't have to ask God to install the Spirit into our spirit. The Holy Spirit comes with all the promises of who God is. The Spirit comes with all the fruit of the Spirit, and all the gifts of the Spirit. We have received!

Another unique fulfillment of this promise is what Jesus said to all of us:

Lu 11:10 "For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."

Most of us have been influenced to think that we still need to ask, still need to seek, and we still need to knock for the promises of God to come to us. This is a bad misconception and misunderstanding. When Jesus spoke these words, no one could be born again, because He had not yet been glorified. Now, in the new covenant, we can all be born again, and when we are, we receive, we find, and the door is opened to us.

All of the promises move from being outside of us to inside of us! What didn't we receive? What didn't we find? What didn't get opened to us? When we received Christ, we receive all that heaven is. This empowers us in every way to overcome, win the victory, and fulfill all that God has for us.

It is like being given a VISA card to take care of every financial need we have; however, this VISA card is greater in power and reach. The name of Jesus is abundantly able to do far more, not only to help us get the finances we need, but to heal, deliver, cast out demons, and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

We are redeemed from the curse of the law, this is a powerful truth. Instead of asking for help, begin to thank God for the help He's already given us. Instead of seeking wisdom, as if it is outside of us, begin to acknowledge that

Jesus is our wisdom--who is inside of us. This verse is now the game plan of every Christian:

Philemon 1:6 "...that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus."
